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Giant Lock Box Expands Shipping Container Sales and Delivery to All 50 States

Giant Lock Box, a family-operated shipping container supplier headquartered in Middletown, New York, today announced the expansion of its container sales and delivery operations to all 50 states. The move transforms a company long known as a Northeast regional supplier into a national provider ? while keeping every quote, reservation, and site consultation routed through placement experts at its Middletown depot rather than a call center.

The expansion arrives at a moment when demand for secure, ground-level storage continues to climb across construction, agriculture, retail, and residential markets, and when buyers increasingly report frustration with lead-generation websites that broker containers they never inspect. Giant LockBox has taken the opposite position: real inventory, real phone numbers, and pricing locked before payment is ever collected.

"Most people don't get burned on the container. They get burned on everything around it ? surprise delivery fees, a truck that can't make the turn, a unit that looks nothing like the photos," said a Giant Lock Box spokesperson. "Going nationwide only works if the standards travel with it. Every customer in every state still talks to a placement expert who will tell them, before they spend a dollar, whether their site works, what the

all-in price is, and what to do if it doesn't fit."

The company's core differentiator remains its delivery operation. Giant LockBox runs its own tilt-bed delivery trucks across New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Connecticut, and Massachusetts, with same-week delivery available throughout that corridor. For the remaining states, the company dispatches through a network of vetted regional carriers, with typical delivery windows of one to three weeks depending on distance and route density.

Placement ? not just delivery ? is the operative word. The company's crane truck and tilt-bed capabilities allow containers to be set precisely on constrained sites: long driveways, tight gates, sloped ground, tree-lined lots, and properties governed by HOA restrictions. Placement experts walk customers through site requirements by phone before dispatch, a step the company credits with eliminating the failed-delivery scenarios common in the industry.

Giant LockBox has paired the expansion with a pricing policy that stands apart in a market rife with "starting at" advertising. Every quote converts to a final delivered number ? container, condition grade, delivery, modifications, and any access surcharges itemized ? on the first call. No payment is collected online; customers authorize payment by phone only after site access is confirmed and the price is locked, and may cancel any time before that point.

The company's full inventory of Giant LockBox shipping containers for sale spans 20-foot and 40-foot standard units, 20-foot, 40-foot, and 45-foot high-cube containers, double-door and open-sided configurations, and refrigerated and insulated units. Containers are graded across one-trip, cargo-worthy, wind-and-water-tight, and as-is conditions, with grading standards published openly on the company's website. Modification services ? including container offices, workshops, gyms, studios, and pop-up retail builds ? are available nationwide.

Founded as a Northeast supplier serving New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Rhode Island, and Texas, Giant Lock Box built its business on a simple premise: customers should be able to inspect containers at a real yard, speak to a real person, and know exactly what shows up on the truck. The company's Middletown depot at 71 Dolson Ave remains open to walk-in customers six days a week, and holds a 5.0 out of 5 rating on Google.

The nationwide rollout includes dedicated service pages for all 50 states, allowing buyers from Maine to Hawaii to request quotes, review local delivery logistics, and reach the same Middletown-based team.
